

***Essential information for visitors attending the exhibition of the 2nd Riga International Biennial of Contemporary Art, RIBOCA2.**

Every visitor before entering the exhibition territory must read these regulations. By entering the exhibition territory you acknowledge that you have read the regulations and that you agree to abide by the outlined rules during your visit.

The exhibition of the 2nd Riga International Biennial of Contemporary Art titled *and suddenly it all blossoms* takes place in Andrejsala, Riga, with a general area of 200 000 m².

The area where the exhibition is located is a vast industrial site that is simultaneously used as an exhibition venue and film set where active filming is taking place. The territory around the main exhibition area is a customs zone. We ask you to be aware of the surroundings for the duration of your visit and where applicable follow the route on the map, signage placed in the area and directions given by the staff. Taking into account the industrial specifics of the venue, outdoor areas near the water and natural soil and gravel roads, considering the weather conditions, we would recommend you to wear suitable clothing and shoes.

All persons entering the exhibition area do so at their own risk. You are responsible for your actions, health and safety, as well as those of any minors and pets under your supervision.

Filming

- By entering the area of the exhibition, you agree that you or your child as visitors of the exhibition can be filmed and photographed, and appear in the film or any other documentation materials of the event.
- You agree that your and your child's appearance in the film and other documentation material of the event will not be individually confirmed or reviewed with you.
- If you do not wish to be filmed ask the staff which areas of the exhibition you shouldn't enter on the day of the visit. If you do not wish to be photographed, inform the photographer personally.

Health and Safety Recommendations:

- follow the route on the map. Respect warning signs placed in the area and directions given by the staff; do not enter parts that are marked with "no access" signs;
- keep 2 meters distance between you and other visitors, disinfect your hands, use disposable gloves and follow other COVID-19 related restrictions;
- do not touch and climb on artworks, except in places where it is specifically allowed;
- the territory around the main building is an active customs zone and harbor. Please, respect working harbor industry and do not go outside gated areas;
- be careful not to stumble;
- put on clothes suitable for the weather and long walks;
- do not swim in the area of Andrejsala;
- respect working hours and leave territory before 20:00;

When purchasing a ticket to the exhibition or entering the exhibition territory you confirm that you have read, understood and accepted terms and conditions stated above and agree that your personal data can be processed as far as it is necessary for protection of legal interests of association "Riga International Biennial" as the main organizer of RIBOCA2.
